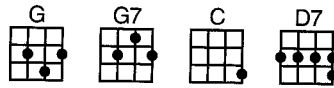

^{D7} Kohu maka kui keke 'inikiniki i ka 'ili ^G

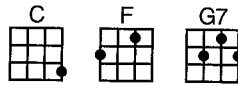
The steady approach of the sudden Nāulu rains
