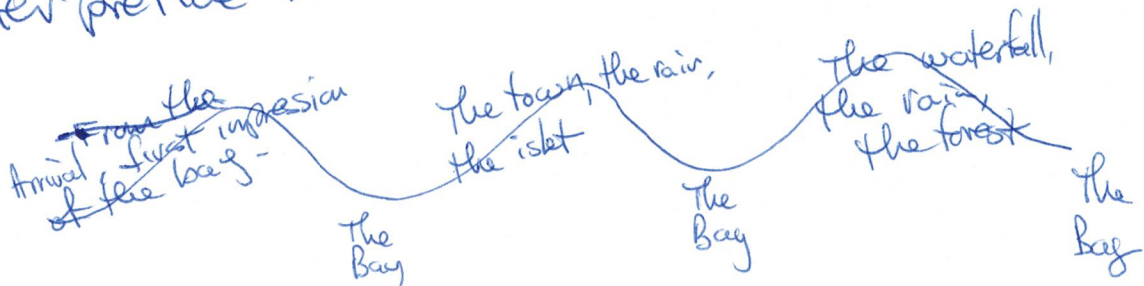


Kohio Bay is east of Hilo Bay, they are separated by Mokuola. Kohio Bay has the harbor.

Waianene is in a different ahupua'a, so the song ~~is~~ is treating the whole Hilo region.

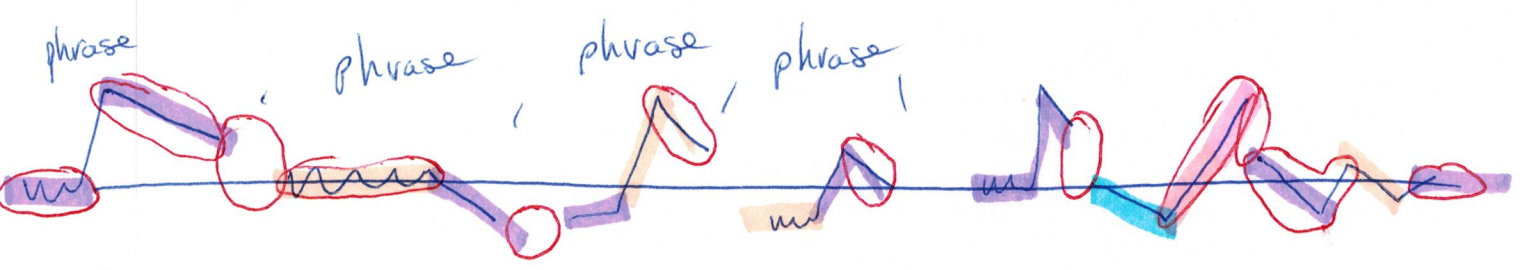
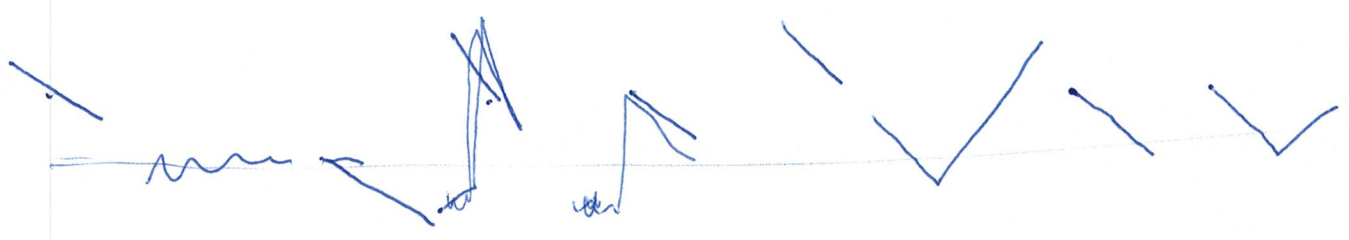
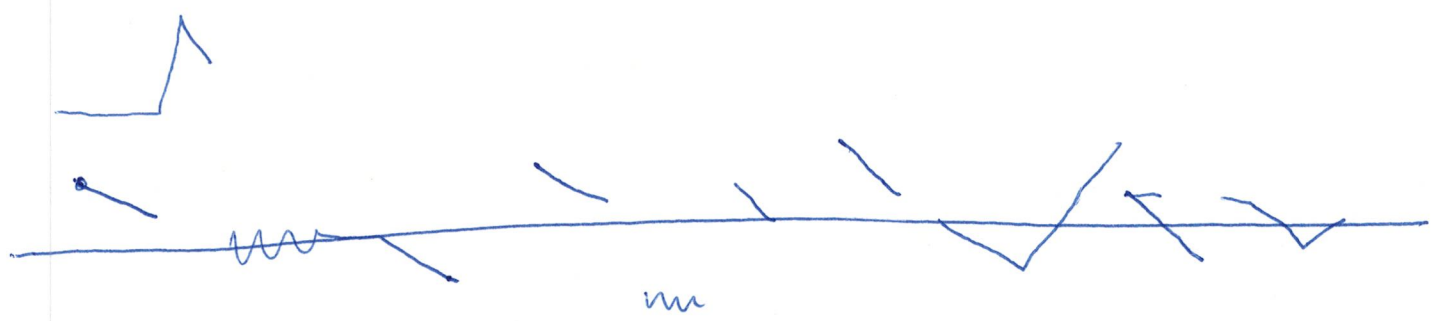
Waiakea ~~may~~ might also refer to the point-peninsula where all the hotels are.
