Kalākaua is his name

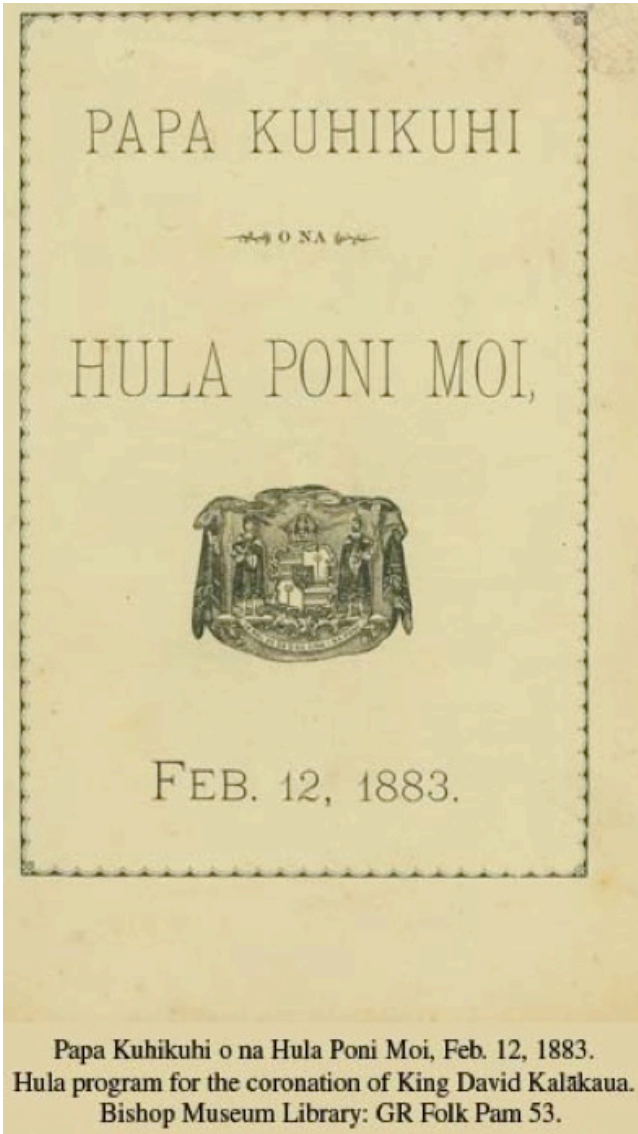
