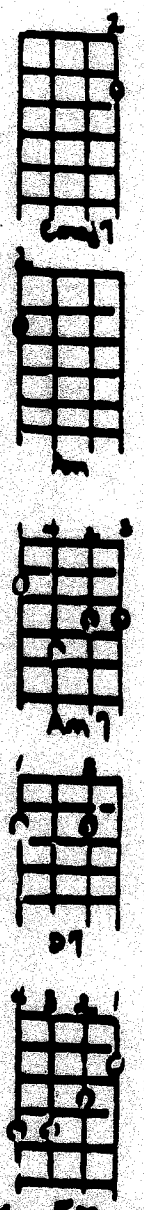


DAYS OF MY YOUTH
